

NAZARETH BOROUGH COUNCIL--SPECIAL MEETING--NOVEMBER 18, 2015

A special meeting of the Borough of Nazareth was held on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. at the Nazareth Borough Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by the President, followed by the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Present were President Daniel Chiavaroli, Vice President Larry Stoudt, Mayor Carl Strye Jr., Councilpersons John N. Samus, Lance E. Colondo, Carl A. Fischl, Frank S. Maurek, Michael Kopach and Brian F. Regn and Solicitor Alfred S. Pierce. Absent was Councilman Charles A. Donello.

Recognition of Citizens From the Floor: None.

Law: John N. Samus moved and Brian F. Regn seconded a motion to appoint Doctor Barbara Fischl to fill the unexpired term of Cliff Hess on the Borough's Planning Commission. The term expires on December 31, 2018.

The motion passed unanimously. There was one (1) abstention.

Police: Carl A. Fischl moved and Lance E. Colondo seconded a motion to approve Resolution No. 11 - 15 - F certifying the resignation of Frederick Lahovski from the Nazareth Police Department, effective November 11, 2015 as follows:
